

Cloverdale Farmers & Makers Market

The mission of this market is to support the growth of our local economy and provide access to high-quality, locally grown food and goods. We promote and provide activities that grow, nourish, and entertain our community. The purpose and objective of this market is to sell locally grown plants, fruits, vegetables, flowers, baked goods, jams & jellies, as well as hand and homemade goods. All goods must adhere to the Home Based Vendor guidelines. No flea market item sales.

Rules and Guidelines 2026

1. Purpose and objective
 - a. Sell locally grown plants, fruits, vegetables, flowers, baked goods, jams & jellies.
 - b. Sell locally handmade, repurposed products. No mass produced flea market items.
 - c. Organize/participate in activities that encourage growth of local economy and market.
 - d. Money collected from vendors, runs the market. Market master/manager is not a paid position.
2. Vendor agreements
 - a. Vendors must provide name, address, phone number and email if you have one. Email will be a main source of correspondence prior to start of market.
 - b. Fees must be paid on first day of participation.
 - c. Booth size approximately 10x15.
 - d. Vendor must supply all supplies and please remove trash in your area after tear down.
 - e. There will be a limited amount of space for vendors to sell out of back of their vehicle. One vehicle per spot if available. These will need preapproved before market day.
 - f. Vehicles must be moved to parking area once unloaded. No driving in grass.
 - g. No power provided. You may bring a small generator. Approval needed prior.
 - h. Manager has full authority to assign spaces.
 - i. All handcrafted items must be preapproved by manager before bringing to the market. This helps to ensure quality of goods at market.
 - j. Vendors are responsible for obtaining all permits needed to sell their products prior to participating. As well as following all health codes that apply to Farmers Markets, Home Based Vendors, Indiana Egg Board, or Retail Establishments.
 - k. We will be limiting the same type of crafts to 2. Example: 2 crochet vendors, 2 sewing vendors etc. Currently no limit on home grown produce.

3. Manager
 - a. Manager is responsible for enforcing rules. Vendor who continually breaks rules will be asked to leave without reimbursement.
 - b. Vendor who questions another vendor products legitimacy must direct concern to manager.
 - c. Vendors are encouraged to obtain their own liability insurance.
 - d. Decisions made by manager are final.

Market runs every Saturday from 8am-12pm, May-August

Fees are \$50.00 for season, \$20.00 for one day.
